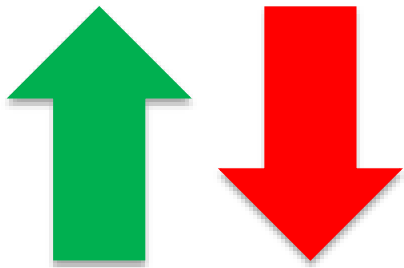

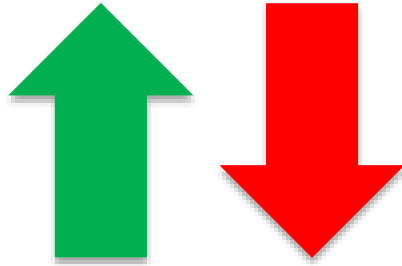

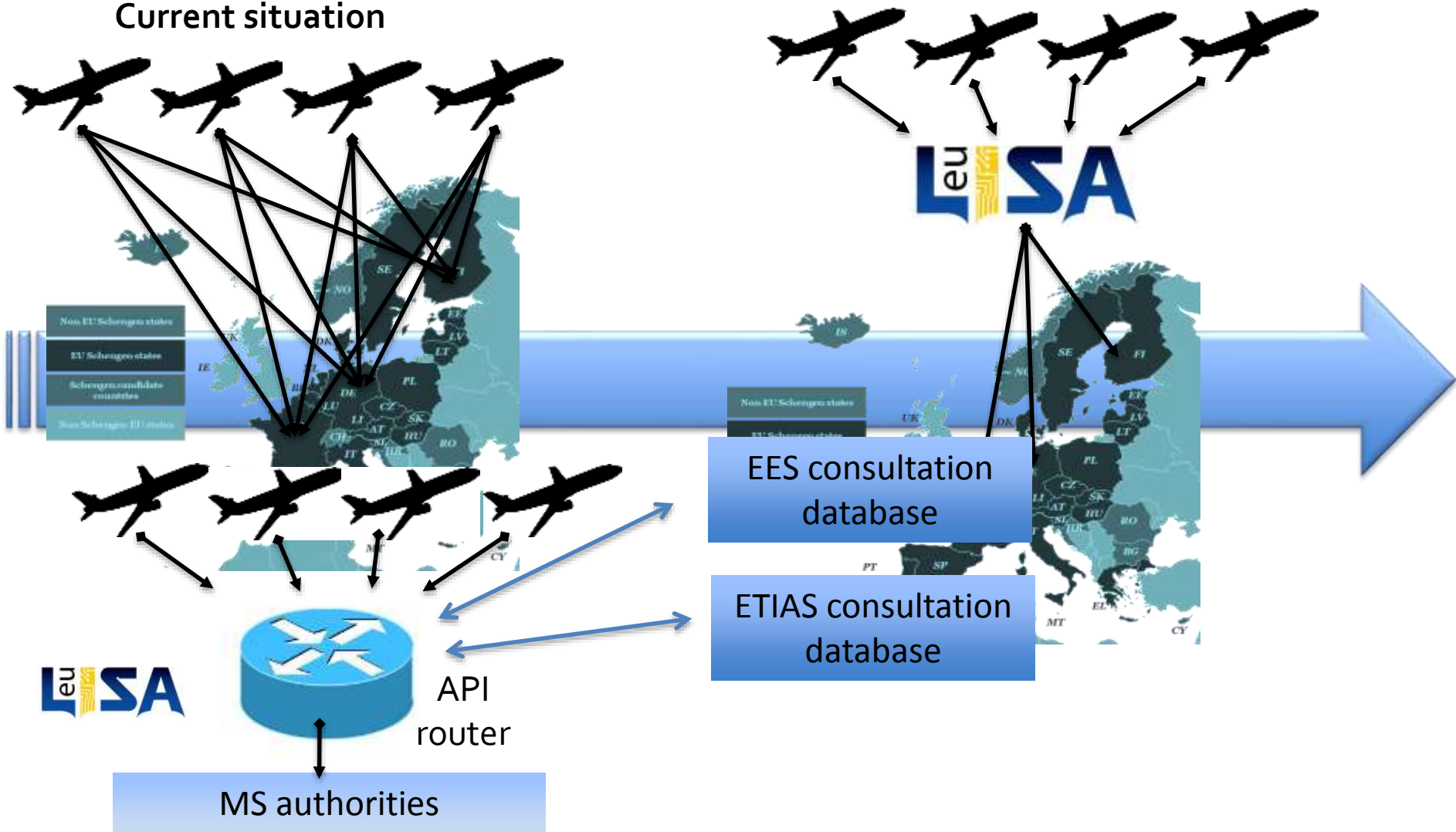

A centralised API router

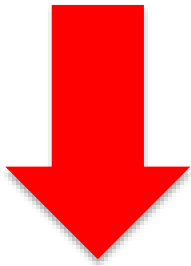
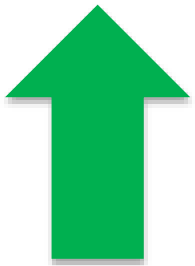
Current situation
