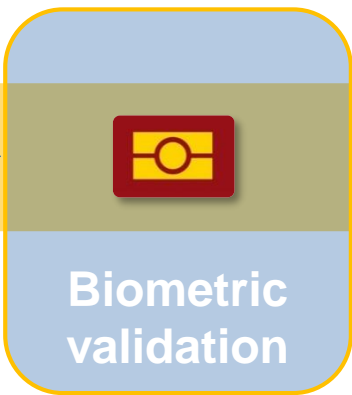
Towards a digitalisation of procedures at the external borders

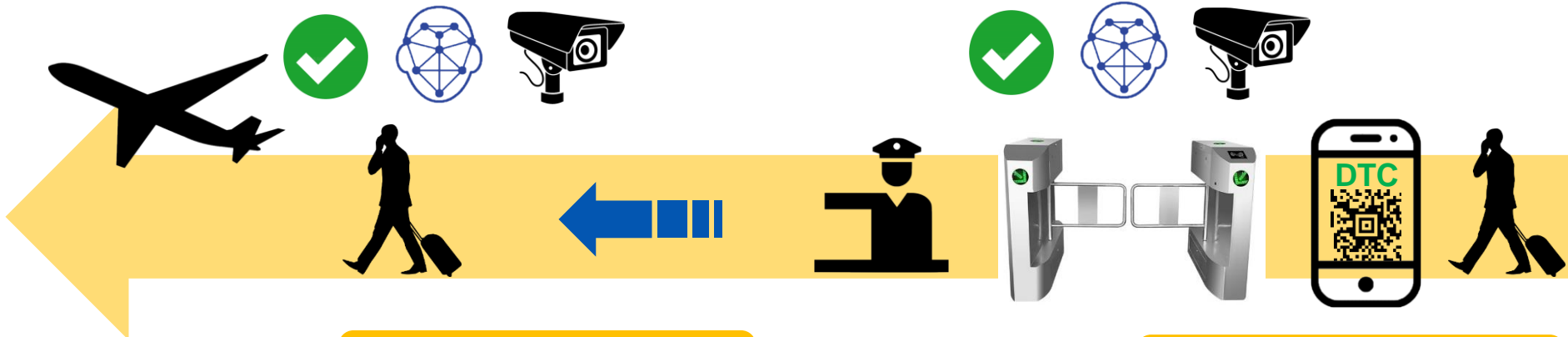

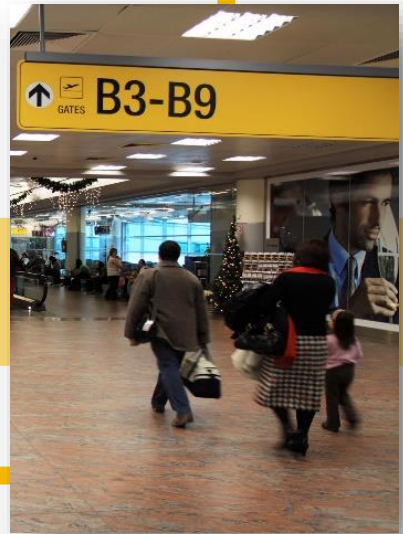
