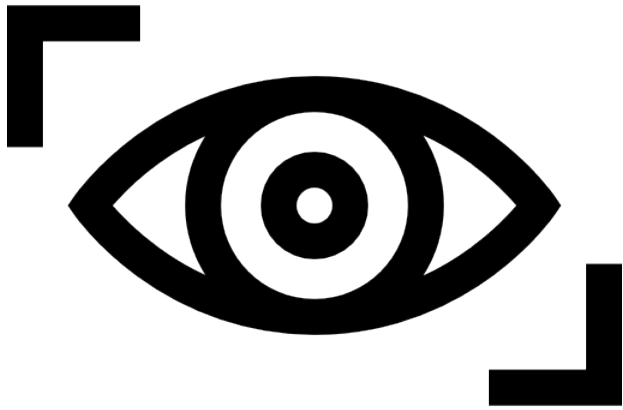

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Industry vision



- IATA's vision of the end-to-end journey, according to OneID, allows for **simplified, efficient, secure, and seamless** process.
- Key enablers for that vision
 - ✓ **Digitalization of admissibility in advance** of travel
 - ✓ **Contactless** travel through **biometric enabled** identification

A glance to EES/ETIAS

- IATA supports Electronic Travel Systems (ETS), and therefore, EES/ETIAS
- EES/ETIAS will be the most impactful ETS implemented worldwide. Standardization & strong /timely communication to the public are key
- Elements preventing EES/ETIAS in its current form from achieving the full potential of an efficient ETS



PRE-DEPARTURE

- Not all immigration checks/travelers are in the scope of EES /ETIAS
- Responses to carrier lack of granularity
- Support to carriers when dealing with travelers, via web and with limited scope

ON ARRIVAL

- Potential lack of efficient readiness in terms of processes and resources at border control points
- Lack of off-airport enrolment for TCN before departure

The carriers' readiness



- **Actions** for carriers to get ready for EES/ETIAS
 - ✓ Connect Airlines' systems to the Carrier Interface
 - ✓ Adapt operational processes
 - ✓ Adapt online services
 - ✓ Train staff across network
 - ✓ Update and expand customer communication channels
- **Challenges** faced for an effective readiness
 - ✓ Not straightforward registration process
 - ✓ Non-effective communication flow during registration/IT setup
 - ✓ Non-flexible with some industry proposals to follow standards/intl. practices

The efficient implementation

PRE-DEPARTURE



Carriers

- Enhance communication / resources available to carriers during the IT setup process
- Expansion of the type of visas in scope to be advanced at the EiO
- 24/7 phone support to carriers once the system is live

ON ARRIVAL

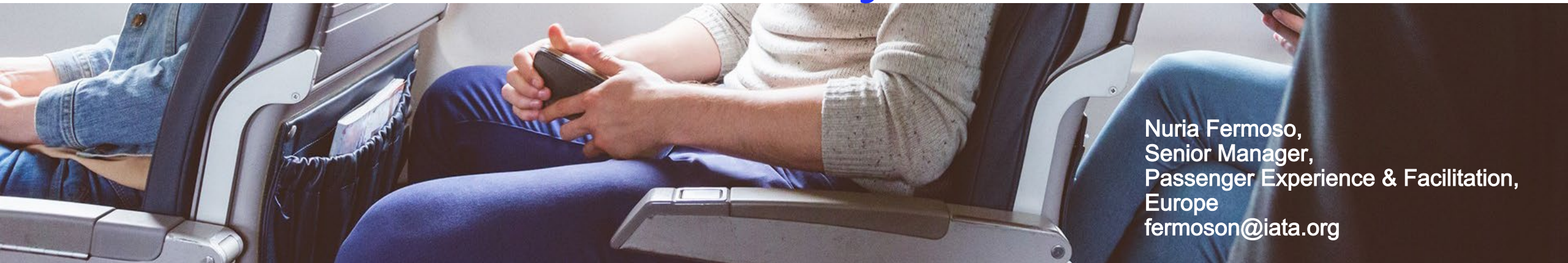


Schengen Border Crossing Points

- Efficient border control procedures
- Effective deployment of resources at border crossing points
- EU App for TCN to enroll at the airport and on departure, ready for the EiO
- Secure a “low season” timeline for the EiO
- Minimum Connecting Times shall be respected
